

During that year, she studied the Nepali language, tabla (Indian/Nepal classical music), yoga, travelled the country with Environmental NGOs, studied in a Tibetan monastery, and lived and studied with Newari Woodcarvers in a woodcarving village.

Since then she co-founded the Mountain Music Project, which is a non-profit working to preserve and promote endangered traditional mountain musics. She helped to make a documentary about the music of Nepal and the amazing similarities with old time and bluegrass in the Appalachian mountains where she is from.

She has performed with and presented on Himalayan and Appalachian musics in Nepal and the US at places like The Smithsonian Folklife Festival, National Geographic, The Rubin Museum, and many festivals, universities, and arts organisations. With her fun loving nature, expertise and networks of friends and colleagues throughout Nepal, she can provide a really fun and unique trip.
